BEING A BY-LAW TO REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 2117(1990)
AND TO DEDESIGNATE THE OLD CNR RAILWAY STATION

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Wingham passed By-law No. 2117(1990) under which the old CNR Railway Station was designated as being of historical value in the community;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Wingham has acquired ownership of the railway lands in the municipality including the old CNR Railway Station;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Wingham now wishes to sell a portion of the railway land and deems that the historical designation of the property may detract potential purchasers who may or may not wish to retain the structure either in its historical state or at all;

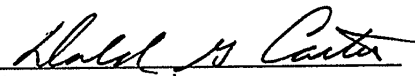
AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Wingham has caused such Notice of Intention to dedesignate to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;


AND WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed dedesignation has been served on the Clerk of the Municipality;

NOW THEREFORE By-law No. 2117(1990) is hereby repealed and the property identified as the old CNR Railway Station is hereby dedesignated and deemed to have no further historical value in the community under the Ontario Heritage Act.
