NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Port Hope and Hope intends to designate the property including the lands and buildings, at the following municipal address(es) as a property of architectural and/or historical value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990.

31 Queen Street - The 1912 Carnegie Library in Port Hope has historical significance, because it is one of 96 out of 125 still remaining, and once it is restored to its original splendour, it will once again be architecturally important to the Queen Street streetscape, and will be a fitting memorial to a very generous individual.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts may be served on the Clerk of the Town of Port Hope and Hope before the 29th day of January, 2001.
