TAKE NOTICE that the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Port Hope intends to designate property at the following municipal address as a property of architectural and/or historical value or interest, pursuant to the provisions of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 0.18, Part IV.

42 Bruton Street

Reasons for the Proposed Designation

The most easterly of Barrett's Terrace houses, No. 42 was built 37 years after William Barrett, son of the founder of Barrett's Mills, had built the Terrace as a business ventures. In 1892, on selling the family home, the octagon on Martha Street, Williams son, Harold added this townhouse to the row for his own residence. No. 42 is an example of Queen Anne Revival, a Canadian vernacular style popular in the latter part of the nineteenth century. With its deep bays and octagonal towers it makes an attractive landmark at the corner of Ontario and Barrett Streets.
