TAKE NOTICE that the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Port Hope intends to designate the building at the following municipal address as a property of cultural heritage value for architectural and/or historical value or interest, pursuant to the provisions of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 0.18, Part IV:

## Statement of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest

The Swan House is a one and a half storey residential building completed in 1900 as the rural dwelling of Jackson Swan. This modest brick farmhouse was both simple in design and sound of structure accompanied by a barn and enough land to provide a self sufficient lifestyle.

The cultural heritage value of this lovingly preserved early twentieth century dwelling is evident as it is a well maintained, historically authentic example of an Ontario turn of the century vernacular gable front house design.
