Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Neustadt, on the 18th day of July, 1978, decided to designate the premises, known municipally as Geberdt's Shoe Store on Mill Street East, as a property of historical and architectural value or interest under the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S.O. Chapter 122.

Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

Geberdt's Shoe Store, built in the middle 1800's of handhewn field stone with walls approximately 3 feet thick. The doorways and windows are all architecturally keystoneed and illustrate the excellent stone workmanship of the period. It has a history of occupancy as a candy shop, tailor shop, grocery store and has been a shoe store since 1925. There has been virtually no change in the physical characteristics since its construction.

Notice of objection to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty days of the 15th day of August, 1979.
