





NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE PLACES OF ARCHITECTURAL AND/OR HISTORICAL VALUE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Corporation of the City of St. Thomas intends to designate as a place of architectural and/or historical value or interest the property known as the former Public Utilities Commission substation at 36-44 St. Catharine Street, under the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. 0.18.

The detailed reasons for designation of this property can be seen in or obtained from the Office of the Clerk, City Hall, 545 Talbot Street, St. Thomas, Ontario, during normal office hours (8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday).

Any person who objects to the intended designation shall within thirty days after the date of publication of this notice, serve on the City Clerk, a notice of objection in writing, setting out the objection and all relevant facts. The last day for filing an objection is **July 20th**, **1998**.
