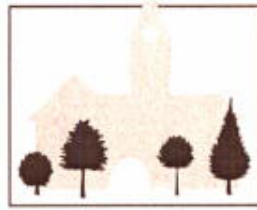

**CITY OF ST. THOMAS**  
**BY-LAW NO. 126 - 2015**

A by-law to repeal By-Law 29-2014, being a by-law to designate Alma Street Presbyterian Church, 40 Alma Street, in the City of St. Thomas, as property of cultural heritage value or interest.

WHEREAS pursuant to the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, the Council of a municipality must pass a repealing by-law upon consent to the demolition of a designated heritage property;

AND WHEREAS City Council consented to the demolition of Alma Street Presbyterian Church, 40 Alma Street.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF ST. THOMAS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-Law 29-2014, being a by-law to designate Alma Street Presbyterian Church, 40 Alma Street, in the City of St. Thomas, as property of cultural heritage value or interest is hereby repealed.
2. This by-law shall take effect on the date of the final passing thereof.

Read a first and second time this 13th day of October, 2015.

Read a third time and finally passed this 13th day of October, 2015.
