By-law 24-18

A By-law to Repeal By-law 73-14
(Being a By-law to Authorize the Designation of 12370 Leslie Street (John Leary House) under the Ontario Heritage Act

Whereas Section 32 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.O.18, as amended, authorizes the Council of a municipality to consent to an application by the owner of the property to repeal the by-law or part of the by-law designating a property;

And Whereas Council at its meeting held November 13, 2017 adopted the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole at its meeting held on November 6, 2017 as contained in Staff Report SRPRS.17.159 pertaining to the application by the owner of the property to repeal the designating by-law for the property located at 12370 Leslie Street subject to the execution of a Commemoration Agreement including appropriate securities with the Town;

And Whereas a Commemoration Agreement between the owner and the Town, requiring cash-in-lieu of securities for the installation of an appropriate commemoration plaque has been executed;

And Whereas the Notice requirements pursuant to Section 32 (11) of the Ontario Heritage Act have been fulfilled;

And Whereas no objection to the proposed application to repeal the Designating By-law has been served on the Town Clerk within the period prescribed by the Ontario Heritage Act,

The Council of The Corporation of The Town of Richmond Hill enacts as follows:

- 1. That By-law 73-14 is hereby repealed.
- 2. That the Town Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-law to be served on the owner of the property and the Ontario Heritage Trust, and publish a Notice of the Passing of this By-law in a newspaper having general circulation in the municipality; and to cause reference to said property to be deleted from the Register established under subsection 27 of the Act.
- That the Town Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" in the Land Registry Office.

4. That Schedule "A" attached to By-law 24-18 is declared to form a part of this Bylaw.
