A by-law to repeal By-law 11-87 designating the

in the City of Mississauga, in the Province of Ontario

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga enacted

known as the Codlin House, as a property being of architectural importance under the  
Ontario Heritage Act;

ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 11-87, a by-law to designate the Codlin House presently located at  
7097-7103 Airport Road, in the City of Mississauga, as being of architectural  
importance, is hereby repealed.
2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served  
on the owner of 7097-7103 Airport Road, and on the Ontario Heritage  
Foundation, and to cause notice of this by-law to be published in a newspaper  
having general circulation in the City of Mississauga;
3. The City Solicitor is hereby directed to register a copy of this by-law against  
the subject property, being composed of that portion of Lot 11, Concession 7  
Southern Division, being Part 1 on Plan of Survey 43R-14065, as set out in  
Schedule 'A' attached hereto.
