





**NOTICE OF THE PASSING OF A BY-LAW BY
THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF COLLINGWOOD**

BY-LAW NO. 02-112


Being a By-law under the provisions of Sub-section 41 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, as amended, by the *Government Efficiency Act, 2002* with respect to the designation a Heritage Conservation District;

By-law No. 02-112 is a By-law to define the area to be designated as the Town of Collingwood Heritage Conservation District as outlined on the attached map (see reverse). A Heritage Conservation District is a collection of buildings, streets, and open spaces that collectively are of special historical or architectural significance to the community.

Please be advised that the legislation governing the designation of a Heritage Conservation District was recently changed by the *Government Efficiency Act, 2002* that was given Royal Assent on November 26, 2002. Therefore, this by-law will **not** automatically be the subject of an Ontario Municipal Board hearing as was previously required. Under the revised *Ontario Heritage Act*, if no notice of appeal is given to the Clerk with in 30 days after this publication of this notice the by-law will come into force on the day following the last day of the appeal period.

TAKE NOTICE that any person or agency may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board in respect of the By-law by filing with the Clerk of the Corporation of the Town of Collingwood, not later than 20th day of January, 2003, a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the by-law and the reason in support of the objection, together with a cheque of \$125.00 payable to the Minister of Finance.
