WHEREAS the owners of the property have applied to Council to dedesignate the property known municipally as 24 Malcolm Street, Almonte, Ontario. and


WHEREAS the local advisory committee has been consulted.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Almonte hereby enacts as follows:


1. That Council repeal by-law #28-1978 in its entirety.
