BY-LAW NO. 1996 - 125

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF OWEN SOUND

A BY-LAW TO REPEAL PART OF BY-LAW NO. 1989 - 96, RELATING TO PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE MAIN STREET PROGRAM OFFICE LOCATED AT 856/858 SECOND AVENUE EAST, UNDER PART IV OF THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT, R.S.O. 1990, CHAPTER O.18, PARAGRAPH 32

WHEREAS Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, Chapter O.18, R.S.O. 1990, authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact By-laws to repeal By-laws designating real property; and

WHEREAS it has been requested by the owners of the Main Street Office located at 856/858 Second Avenue East that the said property designation be repealed, and the Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee has been consulted;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF OWEN SOUND HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. A portion of By-law No. 1986 96, specifically pertaining to the property known as the Main Street Office situated municipally at 856/858 Second Avenue East in the City of Owen Sound, more particularly described in Schedule 'A' attached to By-law No. 1996 125, is repealed.
- 2. The municipal solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this Bylaw to be registered against the property described in Schedule 'A' hereto in the proper land registry office.
- 3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-law to be served upon the owners of the property affected by this By-law and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this By-law to be published once in a newspaper having general circulation in the municipality.
- 4. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.

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SCHEDULE 'A' TO BY-LAW 1996 - 125

THOSE lands and premises located in the following municipality, namely, in the City of Owen Sound, in the County of Grey and Province of Ontario and being composed of part of Lot 9, West of Poulett Street in the said City of Owen Sound, as more particularly described as:

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the City of Owen Sound, in the County of Grey and being composed of Part Lot 9, West of Poulett Street, in the said City of Owen Sound, more particularly described as follows, that is to say:

COMMENCING at a point in the easterly limit of said lot distant 49.65 feet measured South 7 degrees, 15 minutes East thereon from the northeasterly angle of said lot, said point being the intersection of said easterly limit with the northerly face of the northerly wall of the brick building now standing on the herein described lands;

THENCE South 82 degrees, 21 minutes, 20 seconds West along said northerly face and the westerly production thereof a distance of 162.42 feet more or less to the westerly limit of the said Lot 9;

THENCE South 20 degrees, 53 minutes East along said westerly limit a distance of 55.53 feet more or less to the southwesterly angle of said lot;

THENCE North 82 degrees, 45 minutes East along the southerly limit of said lot a distance of 149.33 feet more or less to the southeasterly angle of said lot;

THENCE North 7 degrees, 15 minutes West along the easterly limit of said lot a distance of 55.09 feet more or less to the point of commencement.

SUBJECT to the rights previously granted to the owners of the lands to the immediate north of the hereinbefore described lands by Instrument No. 56212, filed in the North Grey Registry Office, in respect to the northerly wall of the brick building now situated on the hereinbefore described lands.

AND SUBJECT also to the party wall agreement filed in the North Grey Registry Office as Instrument No. 41665.
