NTARIO HERITAGE TRUST By-Law Number 200

By-law to repeal City of Brockville By-law 137-88, being a by-law to Designate the Property known as the Williams Grace House, 12 Grant Street, for Architectural Significance.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brockville passed by-law 137-88 at a Regular Council Meeting held June 14th, 1988, designating the property known as the Williams Grace House, 12 Grant Street, for Architectural Significance; and,

WHEREAS the current property owners of 12 Grant Street have petitioned Council to repeal by-law 137-88; and,

WHEREAS Section 32(2) of the Ontario Heritage Act allows Municipal Councils to repeal a designating by-law, providing that it publishes a notice of the intention to repeal in a newspaper of general circulation in the municipality; and

WHEREAS a Notice of Intention to repeal By-law 137-88 was published in the Recorder and Times Newspaper on Thursday, March 6th, 2008; and

WHEREAS no appeals were filed with the City of Brockville Clerk's Office respecting the repealing of By-law 137-88:

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF **BROCKVILLE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

THAT By-law 137-88, being a by-law to Designate the Property known as the Williams Grace House, 12 Grant Street, for Architectural Significance is hereby repealed.
