Corporation of the Village of Colborne

By-Law Number 95-17

Being a By-Law to designate the property known as VICTORIA PARK bounded by Church Street West - Victoria Square - King Street West and Toronto Street, as being of Architectural and / or historical value or interest.

WHEREAS Chapter 0.18, Section 28 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990 authorizes the Council of a Municipality to enact by-laws to designate real, property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historical value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Colborne has caused to be served on the Ontario Heritage Foundation, Notice of Intention to so designate Victoria Park - including all structures thereon, excluding playground equipment - and has caused such Notice of Intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;

AND WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the Municipality;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Municipality of the Village of Colborne hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. There is designated as being of architectural and / or historical value or interest the real property known as Victoria Park, bounded by Church Street West - Victoria Square - King Street West and Toronto Street.
2. The Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this by-law to be registered against this property in the proper Land Registry Office.
3. The Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this by-law to be served on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause Notice of Passing of this By-Law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the Municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.

THIS BY-LAW READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED, SIGNED, SEALED AND NUMBERED BY-LAW NUMBER 95-17, THIS 14th DAY OF AUGUST, 1995.
