Re: Kingston City Council Meeting, October 4, 2022 – Clause 2ii of Report Number 91: Received from Heritage Kingston with respect to Application for Ontario Heritage Act Approval – 216 Ontario Street

At the regular meeting on September 6, 2022, Council approved Clause 2ii of Report Number 91: Received from Heritage Kingston with respect to Application for Ontario Heritage Act Approval – 216 Ontario Street:

That the alterations and removals within the interior of the property at 216 Ontario Street, be approved in accordance with details described in the application (File Number P18-055- 2022), which was deemed complete on August 18, 2022 with said alteration to include only those works proposed on the interior of the Market Wing western vestibule, such as flooring and door removal; and


That the approval of the interior works be subject to the following conditions:

1. A Building Permit shall be obtained, as necessary;
2. The applicants consider retaining the interior vestibule doors in situ; and
3. Details, including colour(s) of the flooring, painting/wall cladding, shall be submitted to Heritage Planning staff, prior to installation, for review and approval, to ensure they compliment the heritage character and attributes of the property.
