A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS  
ST. PAUL'S PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH, CAINTOWN, R. R. #1 MALLORYTOWN, ONTARIO  
FOR BOTH HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL REASONS

WHEREAS The Ontario Heritage Act, Chapter 337, Part IV, Revised Statutes of Ontario 1980 and amendments thereto authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural and historic value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Front of Yonge has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as St. Paul's Presbyterian Church, Caintown, R. R. #1 Mallorytown, Ontario and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the Brockville Recorder and Times and the Gananoque Reporter, newspapers having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks, and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the clerk of the municipality; and

WHEREAS the reasons for designation are:


The Church is an historical example of a small, rural brick church. The roof is slate, the interior wainscotting seats and pulpit are built of seasoned black ash. The original church was built for \$2,590 and since that time the parish members have very largely provided the monies, labour and materials for any needed improvements. The church has provided continual pastoral service since 1876 to this community. The black ash construction and stained glass windows are original and we wish to preserve these features.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Front of Yonge enacts as follows:

1. There is designated as being of historical and architectural value or interest the real property known as St. Paul's Presbyterian Church, Caintown, R. R. #1, Mallorytown, Ont. more particularly described above.
2. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described herein in the proper land registry office, the Land Registry Office for the Registry Land Titles Division of Leeds (No. 28);
3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspapers having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.
