THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GANANOQUE

BY-LAW No. 78-21

WHEREAS The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 provides that the Council of a municipality, if it desires to designate a property to be of historic or architectural value or interest shall pass a by-law so designating the property.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of The Town of Gananoque enacts as follows:

- 1. The building owned by The Corporation of The Town of Gananoque known as The Clock Tower located upon part of Block "O", East of The Gananoque River, according to Plan 86 of the Town is hereby designated a property of historic and architectural value or interest.
