

## BY-LAW NUMBER 76-13

WHEREAS The Ontario Heritage Act 1974 provides that the council of a municipality if it desires to designate a property to be of historic or architectural value or interest shall pass a by-law so designating the property.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of The Town of Gananoque enacts as follows: -

The building owned by the Corporation of The Town of l. Gananoque and presently used as a Town Hall and Public Library, located upon Lot A, Plan 86, East of the Gananoque River, in the Town of Gananoque, in the County of Leeds is hereby designated a property of historic and architectural value or interest.
