## REASONS FOR THE PROPOSED DESIGNATION

216 Joseph Street, the Garden Inn, is recommended for designation for architectural and historical reasons.

Architecturally significant is the south facade of the original structure, with its graceful bay window and returns under the eaves. The width of the clapboard siding and the detailing surrounding the bay window indicate that this portion of the structure predates the rest of the building, and should be kept intact.

Also of architectural significance are the concrete green frogs on the sidewalk in front of the building. These were sculpted by a previous owner of the property and should be maintained as they add a touch of fantasy to the streetscape.

Historically the Garden Inn is one of the few remaining frame structures that served as guest accomodations when the village was a booming summer resort in the early decades of this century.
