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## THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF L'ORIGNAL

BY-LAW NUMBER 11-83 .

A BY-LAW to designate the property known municipally as 996 King Street, L'Orignal, Ontario as being of architectural and historical value or interest.

WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historical value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of L'Orignal has caused to be served on the owners of the land and premises at 996 King Street, L'Orignal, Ontario and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks; and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the municipality;

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Village of L'Orignal enacts as follows:

- There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the real property at 996 King Street, L'Orignal, Ontario. (more particularly described in Schedule A hereto.)
- 2) The municipal solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property in the proper land registry office.
- 3) The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD time and finally passed this 5th day of APRIL 1983.
