

## **NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE A BUILDING OF HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL VALUE**

**TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Aurora intends to designate the following property in the Town of Aurora, Regional Municipality of York as a property of historical or architectural value pursuant to the provisions of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. O-18, Part IV.**

237- 253 Old Yonge St.

**Reasons for the proposed designation can be obtained by contacting the Town Clerk, Town of Aurora.**

**Any person may on, or before the 4<sup>th</sup> day of July 2002, send by registered mail or delivered to the Town Clerk, 100 John West Way, Aurora, Ontario L4G 6J1 a Notice of Objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant fact. If a Notice of Objection is received, the Town Council will refer the matter to the Province's Conservation Review Board for a hearing and a report.**
