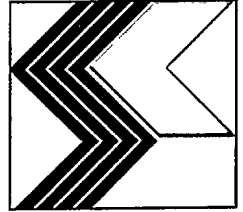

Please be advised that the Council of the City of St. Catharines resolved its intention on July 23, 2001 to repeal the by-law designating the above property under the Ontario Heritage Act.

Port Dalhousie is proposed for Heritage Conservation District designation under the Ontario Heritage Act. The above noted property will be included within the Heritage Conservation District. As such, it will still be designated under the Ontario Heritage Act. The policies of the Port Dalhousie Heritage Conservation District Guidelines for Conservation and Change will apply to the subject lands as well as all properties (public and private) within the Heritage District. To meet the requirements of the Act however, individual designation must be removed before properties can be included within the district.
