NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto, on the 2nd day of June, 1978, decided to designate the lands and buildings, known municipally as Nos.35-39 Front Street East, as a property of architectural value or interest under The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, 1974 S.O. Chapter 122.

Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

Nos.35-39 Front Street East (T. Griffith Block, later Beardmore Building). The Beardmore Building is recommended for designation for architectural reasons. Built in 1872, it is one of the first major designs of the important Toronto Architect, David Roberts. A fine example of a commercial building for the period which incorporates three shops, each having an entrance and two windows flanked by decorative cast iron pilasters. A variety of semi-circular arched window openings in brick, a fourth floor mansard roof with decorative dormers and a raised central flagpole platform are distinctive features of the facade.

Notice of objection to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty days of the 16th day of June, 1978. (File 1548).
