

THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT

Notice of Intention to repeal a portion of a by-law designating property of historic or architectural value.

Notice is hereby given that the Council of The Corporation of the City of Woodstock intends to repeal a portion of a by-law designating property of historic or architectural value on the following property for the following reason.

Property:

Perry Street Fire Hall
Perry Street

Portion on which designation is to be repealed is the tongue and groove suspended ceiling.

Reason for Appeal:

Property is presently owned by the City of Woodstock and is being sold for the purpose of commercial development.

A person who objects to the repeal of the portion of the designation set out above shall within thirty days after the date of the first publication of this notice serve on the City Clerk, a notice of objection in writing setting out the objection and all relevant facts.
