Short Statement of Reasons for the Proposed Designation

Nos.76-78 Gerrard Street West is recommended for designation for architectural reasons. This semi-detached house was built in 1889 by Frank Phillips, builder. One central projection with tall narrow and slightly arched windows terminates in a gable with a steeply pitched roof. Decorative brick band courses, inset terracotta features and a rough-cast stone base are distinguishing features. It is an important part of the last remaining block of original buildings on Gerrard Street West.
