Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of  
the City of Toronto on the 7th day of March, 1983, having  
considered the application for Consent to Demolish the building  
known municipally as No. 88 Queen Street East, and after giving  
consideration to the matter, decided:

(A) TO REFUSE THE APPLICATION TO DEMOLISH  
DESIGNATED PROPERTY AT 88 QUEEN STREET EAST  
(COOKE'S PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH) AND, IN  
ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 34 OF THE ONTARIO  
HERITAGE ACT, PROHIBIT ANY WORK TO DEMOLISH  
OR REMOVE ANY BUILDING OR STRUCTURE ON THE  
PROPERTY FOR A PERIOD OF 180 DAYS FROM THE  
DATE OF ITS DECISION.
