BY-LAW NO. 44 FOR 1980

Being a by-law to repeal designation of part of lands owned by

WHEREAS the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 provides that Council of a municipality may pass a by-law designating land as a property of historic and of architectural value and interest.

AND WHEREAS by By-Law No. 12 for 1978, The Corporation of the Town of Seaforth designated the lands described therein as a property of historic and architectural value and interest.

AND WHEREAS said By-Law No. 12 was intended to apply only to Part of Lots 28 and 29, Beattie & Starks Survey, Plan 4 of the said Town of Seaforth.

AND WHEREAS the Corporation is desirous of repealing the said By-Law insofar as it affects Part of Lots 28 & 29, Beattie & Starks Survey, Plan 4 of the said Town of Seaforth.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Seaforth enacts as follows:

By-Law No. 12 for 1978 of the Corporation of the Town of Seaforth is hereby repealed insofar as it affects the following described lands, namely:

In the Town of Seaforth, in the County of Huron and Province of Ontario and being composed of Part of Lots 28 and 29 according to Registered Plan No. 4, Beattie & Starks Survey of the said Town of Seaforth, more particularly described as follows: Part 1 of Reference Plan 22R1298. Deposited December 2, 1980, in the Registry Division Office of Huron No. 22.

Read a first and second time this 15th day of December, 1980.

Read a third time and finally passed this 15th day of December, 1980.
