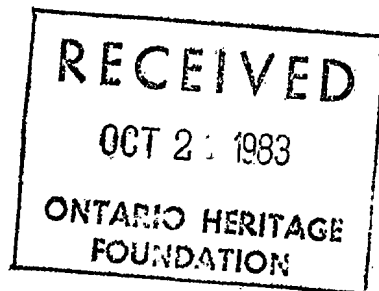

Council at their meeting on the 11th day of October, 1983 decided to designate the lands and buildings known municipally as "The Carnohan House", 123 James Street as property of architectural and historical value or interest under The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980 Chapter 337.
