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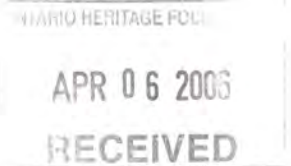

**TOWNSHIP OF CENTRE WELLINGTON**

**BY-LAW NO. 2006-011**

Being a By-law to designate 19 George Street  
in the former Township of Nichol (Salem),  
to be of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest

**WHEREAS** on the advice of the Cultural Heritage Committee, Council has been advised to designate the property noted below to be of cultural heritage value or interest to the provisions of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.O.18;

**AND WHEREAS** the provisions of Section 29, Subsections (1), (2), (3) and (4) have been complied with and no objection has been received by the Municipality.

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTRE WELLINGTON HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The lands and premises described 19 George Street, Nichol Concession 11, Part Lot 15, RP61R6504, Parts 1 & 2, Salem, (Formerly in Township of Nichol), now in Township of Centre Wellington are hereby designated to be a building of cultural heritage value or interest.

2. The reasons for the designation are as follows:

**Cultural Heritage Value or Interest:**


Built in 1880 by Sem Wissler and used as a store and post office. This single detached two storey dwelling with rectangular short façade is constructed of coursed limestone rubble with cut quoins and has a medium gable roof. Recommendation for designation based on historical significance to the village.


**Heritage Attributes to be protected:**

Exterior walls constructed of coarse limestone rubble.  
Cut quoins tooled and hammered.  
Decorative tie rods.



4. This By-law shall come into force and take effect upon its final passing.


