Take notice that the Council of the Corporation
of the City of Toronto, on the 28th day of January and
the 1st day of February, 1985 decided to designate the
lands and buildings known municipally as 223 Front Street
East (Part of the Dalton Complex) as a property of
architectural value or interest, under the Ontario Heritage
Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337.

Short Statement of Reasons for the Proposed Designation

223 Front Street East is recommended for designation for
architectural reasons. Built in 1882 for Standard Woolen
Mills, the building was designed by E.J. Lennox, Architect.
There were later additions in 1893 and 1899. It is typical
of industrial loft buildings of the period, having a
symmetrical facade and ordered fenestration with segmental
brick arches and corbelled brickwork at the cornice. The
building is important in context with adjacent buildings
that all together form an integral part of the significant
architectural character of this block of Front Street East
and Berkeley Street.

Notice of the Objection to the designation may be
served on the Clerk within thirty days of the 19th day of
February, 1985.
