THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GODERICH
BY-LAW NO. 9 OF 1990

A by-law to designate properties of Architectural and/or Historical significance as Heritage properties under the terms of Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1980, R.S.O., Chapter 337.

WHEREAS the Ontario Heritage Act, 1980, authorizes Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all the buildings and structures thereon to be of architectural and/or historical significance;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Goderich has cause to be served upon the owners of the lands and premises listed in Schedule A, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation Notice of Intention to Designate these real properties and has caused such Notice of Intention to be published in a newspaper having a general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;

AND WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the said proposed designations has been served upon the Clerk of the municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GODERICH ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. All real property, as described in Schedule A of this by-law, is designated as being of architectural and/or historical significance.
2. The Town Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule A in the proper land registry office.
3. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owners of the properties described in Schedule A and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of this by-law to be published in a newspaper having a general circulation in the Town of Goderich.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS FIFTH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1990.
