Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto, on the 4th day of February, 1976, decided to designate the lands and buildings, known municipally as 1190-1192 King Street West, as a property of architectural value or interest under The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, 1974 S.O. Chapter 122.

Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

1190-1192 King Street West (N). Offices of the Metallic Roofing Company of Canada. The offices of the Metallic Roofing Company of Canada, built c. 1905, are recommended for designation for architectural reasons as a fine example and the most complete example remaining in Toronto of the use of pressed metal for exterior and interior finishes. The use of this material allowed a maximum decorative effect at very little cost.

Notice of objection to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty days of the 13th day of February, 1976. (Reference File 1046).
