## NOTICE OF DECISION

Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto on the 9th, 10th and 12th days of November, 1976, pursuant to the Notice of Hearing dated November 4, 1976, having considered the application for Consent to Demolish and Remove the Bank of Nova Scotia located on the property known municipally as No.440 College Street, and after giving consideration to the matter, decided:

(A) TO REFUSE THE APPLICATION TO DEMOLISH UNDER SECTION 34 OF THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT AND PROHIBIT ANY WORK TO DEMOLISH OR REMOVE ANY

BUILDING OR STRUCTURE ON THE PROPERTY FOR A PERIOD OF ONE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY (180) DAYS FROM THE 12TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1976;

- (B) TO REFUSE THE APPLICATION TO DEMOLISH THE BANK
  OF NOVA SCOTIA AT NO.440 COLLEGE STREET UNDER
  SECTION 37a OF THE PLANNING ACT; AND
- (C) TO APPOINT A COMMITTEE COMPOSED OF

  ALDERMAN ALLAN SPARROW
