OF BY-LAW 84-127-H

On December 17, 1984 the Corporation of the Town of Flamborough passed By-law 84-127-H, being a By-law to designate the property municipally known as 104 Inksetter Road, (Part Lot 33, Concession 1 (Beverly) Town of Flamborough), under the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974.

Since that time a portion of this property has been severed and sold. As the severed lot has no heritage significance it is no longer appropriate that it be designated as a heritage property.

Therefore, under the authority of the Ontario Heritage Act, the Corporation of the Town of Flamborough proposes to pass a By-law to repeal the heritage designation on the severed property which is municipally known as 88 Inksetter Road, (Part Lot 33, Concession 1 (Beverly) Town of Flamborough).
