## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON BY-LAW NO. 86 - 4

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A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE A LAND AND PREMISES KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS THE WHITE HOUSE, LOT 15, CONCESSION 9, GORES LANDING, ONT.

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O., 1980, Chapter 337, authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historic value or interest, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Hamilton has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as The White House at Lot 15, Concession 9, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks, and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the clerk of the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Hamilton enacts as follows:

- There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the real property known as the White House, Lot 15, Concession 9, more particularly described in Schedule 'A' hereto.
- The municipal solicitor is hereby authorized to 2. cause a copy of the by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule 'A' hereto in the proper Land Registry Office.
- The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.

This By-law given a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD READING and FINALLY PASSED this 21st day of January, 1986.
