
Is one of the earliest original houses remaining in Gores Landing. The original section of the house was built in the Ontario Classic style with Georgian symmetry.

This house was built in circa 1850 in the classical style. The front and sides of this storey and a half frame structure have six over six windows and returning eaves on the gable ends. The front door has side lights and pilasters.
