NOTICE OF INTENT TO HISTORICALLY DESIGNATE CERTAIN PROPERTIES

JUL 10 1933

Notice is hereby given by the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Flamborough of its' intent to designate the following properties under the Ontario Heritage Act, to be of historic or architectural value or interest:

The building known as the Troy School located at Part Lot 7, Concession 3, (Beverly) more specifically, adjacent to the Troy United Church on Hwy. 5 is to be designated in recognition of the original shiplap siding and wooden trim; the tower with its round headed double window; the "rose" window; the pedimented dormer and its bellcast mansard roof.

The building known as the Wallace House located at 173 Mill Street N., Waterdown, is being designated in recognition of all four exterior stone elevations including the stone masonry, original windows and shutters and the doorway with transom and sidelights. Interior features to be designated include the original wooden stair bannister and the original wood panelling in the living room. The stone carriage house is also to be designated.

Any person wishing to object to the designation of these properties may do so by serving notice on the Clerk of the Town of Flamborough no later than July 19, 1995, setting out the reasons for the objections and all relevant facts.
