TOWN OF NAPANEE

BY-LAW 586-85


A By-law to designate a certain building to be of historical significance.
WHEREAS it is deemed desirable by the Council of the Town of Napanee that
a certain building within the Town be designated as a building of
historical significance.

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted as a by-law of the Town of Napanee by the
Council thereof as follows:

- (1) That the following building in the Town of Napanee be designated
as a building of historical significance:
 - (a) 14 Mill St.
(Lot 7 & 8 south side of Mill St.)
The stone dwelling and attached factory were built between 1850 and
1875. This stone, a common fabric and it conveys a style and
ornamental detail representing preferences in the second half of
the nineteenth century.

This by-law will become effective on the date of its passing.

By-law read a first, second and third time and finally passed this
17th day of June 1985.
