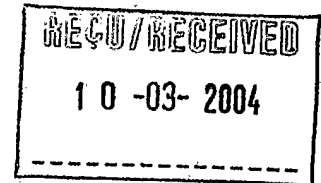

HERITAGE DESIGNATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Waterloo intends to designate the hereinafter mentioned property to be of historic and architectural importance within the meaning of Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990.

The subject lands are located at 45 Young Street West, Waterloo. It is recommended that all of the facades of the original house be designated for architectural and cultural-heritage purposes pursuant to the Ontario Heritage Act.”
