BY-LAW NO. 90-17

BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PUMPHOUSE, 17 AND 23 WILLIAM STREET EAST, IN THE CITY OF WATERLOO, IN THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF WATERLOO, TO BE OF HISTORIC AND ARCHITECTURAL VALUE AND INTEREST.

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O.
1980 authorizes Council of a municipality to designate property
within the municipality to be of historic value or interest;

AND WHEREAS Council for The Corporation of the City of Waterloo deems it desirable to designate the Pumphouse, 17 and 23 William Street East, built in 1899, to be of historic and architectural value and interest;

AND WHEREAS the Clerk of the City of Waterloo has caused Notice of Intention to Designate to be given in accordance with Section 29(3) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980;

AND WHEREAS no Notice of Objection has been served on the Clerk within the meaning of Section 29(5) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF WATERLOO ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

 The property described in Schedule "A" attached hereto is hereby designated to be of historic and architectural value and interest. This By-law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof by the Council of The Corporation of the City of Waterloo.
