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NOTICE OF INTENTION TO AMEND HERITAGE DESIGNATING BY-LAW

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Waterloo intends to amend Heritage Designating By-law No. 93-59 relating to the Patterson House. By-law No. 93-59 was enacted by The Corporation of the City of Waterloo on April 19, 1993, designating the building familiarly known as the Patterson House, 115 William Street West, Waterloo, Ontario, to be of historic and architectural value and interest, pursuant to Section 29 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*; R.S.O. 1990, c. O.18.

Subsection 30.1 (1) authorizes the Council of a municipality to, by by-law, amend a by-law designating property made under Section 29 of the *Ontario Heritage Act* and Section 29 applies with necessary modification to an amending by-law as though it were a by-law to designate property under that section.

The Amending Heritage Designating By-law proposes that Section 2 of the Designating By-law (By-law No. 93-59) shall be deleted and replaced with:

Section 33 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O 1990 shall apply only to the front facades, including the verandah, of the 1898 Queen Anne style dwelling located on the property described in Schedule 'A'. Section 33 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O 1990 shall not apply to the rear and side facades, including the entire roof line, of same.

Notice of objection to this designation may be served on the Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Waterloo within thirty days of this notice. Any notice of objection shall indicate the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. The last day for filing an objection is July 26, 2013.
