THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF WATERLOO

BY-LAW NUMBER 81-166

BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE NIXON  
HOUSE IN THE CITY OF WATERLOO  
TO BE OF HISTORIC AND  
ARCHITECTURAL VALUE AND INTEREST.

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980 Chapter 337 authorizes Council of a municipality to designate property within the municipality to be of historic and architectural value or interest;

AND WHEREAS Council of The Corporation of the City of Waterloo deems it desirable to designate the Nixon House to be of historic and architectural value and interest;

AND WHEREAS the Clerk of the City of Waterloo has caused Notice of Intention to Designate to be given in accordance with Section 29(3) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337;

AND WHEREAS no Notice of Objection has been served on the Clerk within the meaning of Section 29(5) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF WATERLOO ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The property described in Schedule "A" attached hereto is hereby designated to be of historic and architectural value and interest.
2. Section 33(1) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337 shall apply only to the exterior elevations of the Nixon House, as follows:
  - (a) the front or North facade;
  - (b) the side or West facade;
  - (c) the side or East facade.

3. This By-law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof by the Council of The Corporation of the City of Waterloo.
