NOTICE OF INTENTION

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of
Kitchener intends to designate the exterior of the original
building and fieldstone addition at the following municipal
address as being of historic and architectural significance,
under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337.

1198 Highland Road West

The 2 storey farmhouse was constructed in the late
1850's as a 1 1/2 storey Ontario cottage, with a
second storey and fieldstone addition added prior to
1880. The residence is considered to be repre-
sentative of this community's agricultural heritage,
and a method of fieldstone construction rare in the
City.

All elevations of the farmhouse and the fieldstone
addition are proposed for designation. Significant
architectural features include: all fieldstone
building fabric; brick voussoirs; double hung 2/2
sash; wooden window sills and frames; wooden door
frames; and rooflines of both structures.

Any person may, before the 21st day of March, 1989 send by
registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the City of Kitchener
notice of his or her objections to the proposed designation,
together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all
relevant facts. When a Notice of Objection has been received, the
Council of the Corporation of the City of Kitchener will refer the
matter to the Conservation Review Board for a Hearing and report.
