NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

Under the Ontario Heritage Act R.S.O. 1990, c. O.18, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Kincardine intends to designate as a property of historical or architectural value or interest, the following property for the following reasons:

Property: 731 Princes Street, Former Town of Kincardine, Kincardine, ON

REASONS:

The structure is a large Queen Anne revival free standing house built in about 1896 of triple yellow brick with sandstone detailing and wood embellishments including a porch and grey slate roof. Designation includes three façades of the original house, the principle facing west and sides to the north and south. These façades are inclusive of all original windows and trim. The green space to the west of the main façade in front of the building shall remain green space.

FURTHER INFORMATION respecting the proposed designation is available from the Municipality. A person who objects to this proposed designation shall, within thirty days after the date of the publication of the notice of intention, serve on the Clerk of the Municipality, at the address noted in banner, a notice of objection setting out the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts.
