AND IN THE MATTER OF THE LANDS AND PREMISES KNOWN AS THE CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAY STATION, 25 MILLVIEW ROAD, IN THE TOWN OF KAPUSKASING IN THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Kapuskasing intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, at the following municipal address as a property of architectural and historical value or interest under Part 1V of the Ontario Heritage Act, Chapter 337, R.S.O. 1980:

25 MILLVIEW ROAD

REASONS FOR PROPOSED DESIGNATION - The Canadian National Railway Station, Kapuskasing, Ontario, is one of the few brick railway stations in Northeastern Ontario and is closely linked to the development and growth of the Town of Kapuskasing and its history.

ANY PERSON may within thirty (30) days of the first publication of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Town of Kapuskasing notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a NOTICE OF OBJECTION is received, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Kapuskasing shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
