



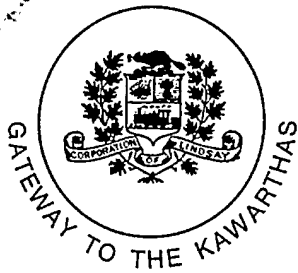

NOTICE OF INTENT TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Town of Lindsay hereby gives Notice of Intent to Designate the building at 60 Bond St., Lindsay, Ontario, as a building of historical or architectural value or interest under the provisions of the Ontario Heritage Act.

The following features are included in the REASONS FOR DESIGNATION:

- Historic Bond Street Landmark
- Excellent example of late Georgian style of architecture
- Unique, well preserved 19th century architectural details
