

BY-LAW NUMBER 14-1990

A BY-LAW TO REPEAL BY-LAW NUMBER 14-1988, A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS THE "EDWARD GREEN PROPERTY", PURSUANT TO THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Rear of Leeds and Lansdowne, pursuant to the Ontario Heritage Act, enacted and passed on June 6, 1988, By-law Number 14-1988, a by-law to designate the property known municipally as the "Edward Green Property", Part of Lot 15, Concession 11, Township of Lansdowne, as being of architectural and historical value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Township of Rear of Leeds and Lansdowne, on January 10, 1990, received a letter from the owners of the "Edward Green Property", requesting the removal of the designation from the property; and

WHEREAS Council of the Corporation of the Township of Rear of Leeds and Lansdowne, pursuant to Section 32 (2) of the Ontario Heritage Act, by resolution passed at its meeting on January 15, 1990, requested comment from the Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee on the request for repeal of Designating By-law 14-1988 on the Green Property; and


WHEREAS the Committee Report, dated March 1, 1990, advised Council that the Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee had passed a motion recommending that the designation of the Green Property not be removed; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 32 (2) (b), By-law 14-1988 may now be repealed;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF REAR OF LEEDS AND LANSDOWNE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT By-law 14-1988, a by-law to designate the property known municipally as the "Edward Green Property", Part of Lot 15, Concession 11, Township of Lansdowne, as being of architectural and historical value or interest, be repealed.
