

TOWNSHIP OF CORNWALL

BY-LAW NO. 3815

BEING A BY-LAW BY THE TOWNSHIP OF CORNWALL TO DESIGNATE THAT PROPERTY OCCUPIED BY QUINN'S STORE AT ST. ANDREWS WEST TO BE OF HISTORICAL VALUE AND INTEREST

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1980, and amendments thereto, Council of the Corporation of the Township of Cornwall has served notice of intention to designate the land set out in Schedule "A" hereto attached and known as Quinn's Store at St. Andrews West as a property within the municipality to be of historical value and interest pursuant to Section 29-1 of the said Ontario Heritage Act;

AND WHEREAS notices pursuant to the said Act were served on the parties thereto,

Now, THEREFORE, Council of the Corporation of the Township of Cornwall enacts as follows:

1. That the land occupied by Quinn's Store and more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto is hereby designated under the provisions of the Heritage Act of Ontario, 1980, as property of historical value. The reason for this designation is that this stone building was originally constructed by the Honourable John Sandfield MacDonald, circa 1865, having served the local population as a tavern and coach stop.


The premises of the building is structurally sound. The Quinn's Store premises has a singular historical value and interest which should be protected not only for the community, but also for the people of Ontario.
