



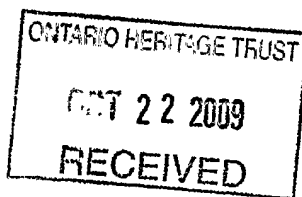

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Newmarket intends to designate the lands known as 221 Prospect Street in the Town of Newmarket, in the Regional Municipality of York, Province of Ontario.

REASONS FOR PROPOSED DESIGNATION

The home located at 221 Prospect Street is an example of "Carpenter Italianate" construction that was very popular in Ontario between the 1840's and 1870's that was copied from pattern books by local master carpenters from local materials.

The house was built by John W. Marsden, a local mill owner and prominent figure in the business and social circles of Newmarket in the period from about 1850 until his death in 1878.

Notice of Objection to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty days of the first date of this publication.
