A BY LAW to designate the William Mirick House #2 Lot 8, Concession B (Montague) Or Plan 6 Broken Concession B, Lot "Ii", of Architectural and Historical value.

Whereas The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, authorizes The Council of a Municipality to enact By Laws to designate Real Property including all the buildings and structures thereon, to be of historic or architectural value or interest, and

Whereas notice of intention to so designate the William Mirick House # 2 Lot 8, Concession B (Montague) Or Plan 6 Broken Concession B Lot "Ii", having been duly published and served and no notice of objection to such designation having been received and, whereas the reasons for the designation are set out as schedule 'B' Hereto;

Therefore The Council of The Village of Merrickville enacts as follows:


1. There is designated as being of Architectural and Historic value or interest The Real Property, more particularly described in schedule 'A' hereto, known as The William Mirick House #2 Lot 8, Concession (B) (Montague) Or Plan 6 Broken Concession B, Lot "Ii"

2. The Village Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By Law to be registered against the property described in schedule 'A' hereto in the proper Land Registry Office.

3. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By Law to be served upon the owner of the aforesaid property, upon The Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of This By Law to be published in The Merrickville Chronicle.

Broken Concession B, Lot "Ii"

Reasons for designation under The Ontario Heritage Act 1974:

"The second William Mirick House now owned by [REDACTED] is certainly one of the oldest stone houses in the Village, having been built between 1800 and 1821. While added to since, the original one and one half story cottage has unusually vertical proportions due to the fact that it has two windows in the upper (front) facade as well as the normal two on the lower part. It also retains a wood shingle roof, which is the material of the original roof cover. The relationship with the larger house (his third) is also important, as is the wide open land running down to the river, showing the relationship that existed when William first built this house."
